

Sleuth integrates with the über librarian

Curio includes a Sleuth site that can query a [DEVONthink Pro Office](#) database using that product's handy, built-in web server.

Setting up the Devonthink Sleuth Site

1. Launch DEVONthink Pro Office as it must be running for Sleuth to communicate with it.
2. Open the database you wish to share and make sure its Share Database property (set via File > Database Properties) is checked.
3. Next, bring up DEVONthink's Preferences and turn on its built-in server.
 - a. Assign a static port of 41111 that it will use even when relaunched. This is also the default port used in the bundled Sleuth site.
 - b. You can assign a different static port but then you will need to customize a copy the bundled Sleuth site. [More details here](#).
 - c. Click the *Start on Launch* checkbox so the server automatically launches the next time you run DEVONthink.
 - d. Click the Start button to start the server.

Using the Devonthink Sleuth Site

1. As a reminder, the DEVONthink Pro Office application must be running and its integrated web server configured as started as detailed above.
2. Bring up Sleuth or the Sleuth shelf and choose DEVONthink.
3. Type in your search phrase and see the results.
4. If you click a found item then it will reveal itself in the DEVONthink application. You can drag-and-drop resulting items into your idea space to create hyperlinks which will open in the DEVONthink application.
